

We are happy to announce that the beach will be open tomorrow, May 24th!!

We have taken all necessary precautions in compliance with the Executive Order 143, which was signed by Governor Murphy on May 14, allowing beaches, boardwalks and lakes to open with certain safety restrictions.

To ensure everyone's safety on Lake Swannanoa, it is important that we all follow the following guidelines:

- **Social distancing** - remain 6 feet apart at all times (except for those in your household).
- **Face masks are encouraged** while you are in the beach area.
- Our beach **maximum capacity is 50 people** (including the grass terrace) .
- The picnic tables have been removed, and the swing set and swim dock will be closed until further notice. Please do not attempt to use these amenities.
- No tying up of boats or rafts in groups
- **Badges must be worn on the beach.** Each household will receive 5 badges (households with more than 5 members will receive additional badges upon request). No more than 5 persons per household should be on the beach at any time. This will allow equal access to all our members without overcrowding the beach.

Signs will be placed throughout the property to reinforce these rules. We hope that everyone can respect these rules for the safety and well being of all our community members.

Additionally:

- The porta- potty has been locked so there are no restroom facilities at this time.
- Yoga and Zumba have been cancelled for now. We will revisit as NJ orders change.
- All beach and Barn group activities such as movie night and birthday parties are cancelled for now. We will revisit as NJ orders change.

Badge pick up for members paid in full will begin tomorrow at 12:30 pm , Janice Giacobbi will have a table **directly across from the beach parking lot** or she can be reached at 917-204-0811 to schedule another convenient time to get your badges. We will also deliver badges next week for those unable to get there tomorrow.

Please note, boat decals have been slightly delayed and we will distribute them shortly. Once boat decals are distributed, we will be checking stickers to ensure that boaters are members, not trespassers.
